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PHILADELPHIA MSA FEBRUARY UNEMPLOYMENT RATE 3.6%

HARRISBURG (APRIL 2) – The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the Philadelphia-Camden-Wilmington, PA-NJ-DE-MD Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) was down one-tenth of a percentage point over the month to 3.6 percent in February. The state unemployment was unchanged over the month at 3.4 percent in February while the national rate rose two-tenths of a percentage point to 3.9 percent.

Seasonally adjusted total nonfarm jobs in the Philadelphia MSA increased 2,300 over the month to a record high of 3,097,400 in February. Over the year, jobs were up 1.3 percent (+40,500) in the MSA, while statewide jobs increased 1.2 percent.

February Not Seasonally Adjusted Nonfarm Jobs Detail

Eight of the ten supersectors added jobs over the month with the largest movements being seasonally driven. The largest gains among supersectors were in education & health services (+15,000) and government (+6,500) as winter break ended at local educational institutions. The largest supersector decline was in trade, transportation & utilities (-7,000) as employers continued to shed seasonal help. Over the year, six of the ten supersectors added jobs with the largest gain in education & health services (+31,800).
