GETTYSBURG MSA OCTOBER UNEMPLOYMENT RATE 2.7%

HARRISBURG (NOVEMBER 28) – The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the Gettysburg Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) was unchanged over the month, remaining at 2.7 percent in October. The state unemployment rate was unchanged from September at 3.4 percent in October, while the national rate was up one-tenth of a percentage point to 3.9 percent. Over the year, the local MSA’s rate declined by seven-tenths of a percentage point, the Pennsylvania rate declined by one percentage point and the national rate increased by two-tenths of a point.

Seasonally adjusted total nonfarm jobs in the Gettysburg MSA were unchanged over the month at 34,400 in October. Over the year, jobs were up 1.2 percent (+400) in the MSA, while statewide jobs were up 2.1 percent.

October Not Seasonally Adjusted Nonfarm Jobs Detail

Over the month, all published supersectors job levels were unchanged. Over the year the largest movements among supersectors was in trade, transportation and utilities (+300) and education & health services (-300).

FOOTNOTES

- 1) Estimate of workers by place of residence. These data are controlled to state Current Population Survey (CPS) data which adjusts for commuting and dual job-holding. Workers are counted where they live only once regardless of the number of jobs they may hold. All in-depth inquiries relative to the estimating methodology should be addressed to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor. All data are subject to revision during annual benchmarking.
- 2) Includes wage and salary workers (including agriculture), self-employed persons, and unpaid family workers (including agriculture), domestic workers, and persons involved in labor-management disputes.
- 3) Unemployed as percent of civilian labor force, computed using unrounded data.
- 4) Seasonally adjusted MSA level data (and their equivalent) is developed by the federal Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS); seasonal adjustment for all other sub-state areas are developed by CWIA.
